Spazio Maiocchi

In 2022, Slam Jam and Demon, two fashion companies in Milan and Montebelluna commissioned an architectural & sculptural monument to be designed and built in the courtyard of the Milanese exhibition space Spazio Maiocchi.

Designed and built by architect and sculptor Marc Leschelier, the purpose of the project was to use construction materials in an unconventional way to use their expressive potential. Using 80 sqm of CC5[™] the material was used to give the impression of four large and imposing columns to which later discovered from viewing the bottom of the structures, they are hollow and are built with a geotextile material.

Marc Leschelier is now using Concrete Canvas[™] in most of his constructions. He considers CC[™] as one of the most revolutionary materials in the field of construction and has helped Leschelier sculpt objects at an architectural scale and to find new applications in the field of architecture.
